Subject **Migration to New VPN Infrastructure for Eurex Repo/SecLend**



Action Required

Dear Participants

Please be advised that the current VPN infrastructure used to establish a secure connection to the Eurex Repo/SecLend trading platform will be replaced. Within the next three months, all Eurex Repo/SecLend participants will have to migrate from the current **CVI** VPN infrastructure (CVI = Common VPN Infrastructure) to the new **SCAP** VPN infrastructure (SCAP = SIX Swiss Exchange Common Access Portal).

The new SCAP infrastructure provides the following benefits:

- Wider selection of carriers who offer lines to the Eurex Repo/SecLend platform.
- Support of a new Cisco VPN hardware client: ASA 5505 Client.
- Higher flexibility to increase or decrease bandwidth in a shorter time period.

### Migration Period

Participants should migrate to the new SCAP infrastructure within the migration period given below:

Environment	Start of Migration	End of Migration
Memberstest	7 December 2009	29 January 2010
Production	14 December 2009	26 February 2010

Please note:

- After the end of the migration period, you will no longer be able to connect to Eurex Repo/SecLend with your current CVI set-up.
- A high number of CVI certificates will expire at the end of the migration period and will have to be renewed anyway. Therefore, you should migrate to SCAP before your certificate expires to avoid additional effort.

**Migration Activities**

The major steps of the migration to the new SCAP infrastructure are summarised below. For full details and instructions on how to migrate, please refer to the document "**CVI to SCAP Migration Guide**", which is attached to this MSC Message.

1. Make sure that your current equipment meets the technical requirements of SCAP (see section 2 in the migration guide).
2. Decide which connectivity option you want to use and contact your carrier as soon as possible to make the necessary arrangements, if applicable (see section 3 in the migration guide).
3. Retrieve your current VPN certificates and complete a full enrolment process for each certificate to establish a connection to the new SCAP environment (see section 5 of the migration guide).
4. Adapt the configuration of your Eurex Repo/SecLend GUI or your USP Proxy and connect via the new SCAP infrastructure (see section 6 in the migration guide).
