 Subject **Decommissioning of Old CVI VPN Infrastructure**



Dear Participants

Dear Eurex Repo / SecLend Participants

The migration to the new SCAP VPN Infrastructure for Eurex Repo/SecLend is now completed (see [MSC Message of 08.12.2009](#)). Therefore, SIX Swiss Exchange will completely decommission the old CVI VPN infrastructure including all old network components on the following dates:

- Membertest environment: 29.05.2010
- Production environment: 12.06.2010

Depending on the network setup of your Eurex Repo/SecLend client applications, this might have an impact on your connection settings. Your client applications now connect to the new SCAP VPN infrastructure but still receive reply messages from the old application server names.

Please be aware that after decommissioning the old CVI network components, connections to the new SCAP FQDNs / IP addresses will get an answer from the new application server names.

Please make sure that you modify your network configuration accordingly (e.g. modify "etc\hosts" file) if necessary.

The table below gives the Fully Qualified Domain Names (FQDNs) and IP addresses of the Eurex Repo/SecLend application servers for the old and the new infrastructure.

To test if your network components resolve the new FQDNs correctly, perform a "ping" to the new hostnames (it does not matter if the ping fails).

If the hostname is resolved to the correct IP address (see table above), your network does not need any change.

In addition, you should change the HTTP Proxy Server Exceptions.

Access to the various online features provided by Eurex Repo/SecLend such as Member Page with Newsboard, Online Help and Statistics. (Memberstest / Production) is not possible via a web-proxy server due to the use of a Cisco VPN Client connection. Therefore, for these specific websites, you need to ensure that you have disabled any potential HTTP proxy server on the client PC.

You should set the following HTTP proxy server exceptions in your web-browser:
